Financial Assistance/Discounts

New Student Discount

Incidental Charges

Thank you for your interest in Mesa Grande Academy, Mesa Grande Academy's School Board attempts to keep the school's tuition and other charges as low as is consistent with good fiscal management. While the tuition payments do not cover our full operating costs, the Southeastern California Conference of Seventh-day Adventists and our Adventist Constituent Churches subsidize our operations. The MGA Board has adopted these policies and they reserve the right to make adjustments as economic conditions warrant. The annual tuition rate is billed over ten installments to help parents in their planning. MGA will not prorate tuition for prolonged absences, vacations or holidays when full academic credit is received.
